## The Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture 2010 Architectural Photography Competition

The Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture presents the 2010 Photography Competition. The top entries will be used in future publications produced by the Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture and AIA Central Oklahoma.

### Eligibility

The competition is open to the following Oklahoma residents.

**Category 1:** Oklahoma Licensed Architects & Intern Architects

**Category 2:** Oklahoma Students

**Category 3:** General Public

**Category 4:** Professional Photographers

### Awards

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place, \$500 cash award, will be awarded in each category.
- Honorable Mentions may also be awarded in each category.
- The top ten entries in each category will be exhibited during Architecture Week 2010, which will be held in April 2010.

### Judges

Judges will include AIA Central Oklahoma Board Member, Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture Board Member, a Professional Photographer, and a representative from the Arts Community.

### Entry Requirements

1. Files may not exceed 20 MB in size and must be entered as a .JPG or TIFF format. File names should not exceed ten letters and should not include punctuation.
2. All entries must be on a compact disk, readable by windows. Please write the entrants name as well as the file name on the disk.
3. Entries must have been exposed by, and owned by, the entrant.
4. The subject matter must have an architectural theme or must contain some element of the manmade environment and be located in the State of Oklahoma. Photographic interpretation of the subject matter is what will be judged, not the architecture.
5. All photographs should accurately reflect the subject matter and the scene as it appeared. Photos that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization will be disqualified. Acceptable are adjustments to color, contrast, brightness and sharpness; removal of dust and scratches; cropping; black and white conversions; and use of HDR (high dynamic range imaging), where multiple exposures of the same scene are combined for a greater tonal range. Not

acceptable are photo composites (combination of two or more photos, not of the same scene); the addition, duplication, deletion or moving of objects in the photos; or the use of artistic digital filters and effects. Examples of artistic filters and effects are watercolor, neon glow, posterizing, stained glass, and others which do not show the scene in its natural way.

6. Entry fees are as follows:

General Public- \$35.00

**Category 4:**

Professional Photographers- \$35.00

*(If you have ever been COMMISSIONED OR COMPENSATED for your photography work, you must enter under the professional PHOTOGRAPHER category)*

7. **Entry forms and payment must be postmarked no later than January 29, 2010. (Please note that each entry (which is ONE PHOTO requires a separate entry form and payment).** Please mail to: Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture, 3535 N. Classen Blvd, Oklahoma City, OK 73118. Official forms and CD will be mailed to you no later than February 15, 2010. **Final Photography submissions are due no later than March 19, 2010.**
8. **All entry fees are nonrefundable.**
9. Entrant grants permission to the Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture (and its partner, AIA Central Oklahoma) to reproduce images for exhibitions, publications, and for promotional purposes. These reproductions will become the property of the Oklahoma City Foundation for Architecture and AIA Central Oklahoma. The photographer will maintain rights to his or her original work.
10. The decisions of the judges are final on all matters relating to the competition.
11. Submission of image(s) implies entrant's acceptance of all of the above conditions.
